Anyone interested in learning to fly is welcome to attend our open Tuesday training nights. SMRCC club members will check out your plane and provide flying instruction or simply provide answers to questions you may have. SMRCC membership is not required to participate.

- AMA (Academy of Model Aeronautics) membership or a free 60 day AMA Intro Pilot program registration is mandatory for flight training.
- Provide a fuel or electric aircraft designed as a “Trainer” (high wing, slow flight characteristics) labeled with owner name, address, and phone number along with support supplies and equipment.
- Transmitting radio with ability to connect a slave control (buddy box). Spectrum, JR, Futaba brands preferred.
- All batteries must be newer, in good condition, and fully charged. Trainee to provide own relevant charging equipment.
- We face the setting sun in the evenings. Quality non-polarized sunglasses and a ball cap are recommended.
- Training instruction is delegated on a first come first served basis. Club members will get priority.
- Trainee accepts all risks and SMRCC training staff is not liable for damages or loss.
- Persons under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
